



DOG POLICIES AND AGREEMENT

To assure the comfort and safety of our dog guests, our staff and other guests, we have established the following policies. Your full cooperation is essential to the success and continuation of our "dog friendly" policy. We wish both you and your dog an enjoyable stay.

I agree to the following terms:

- **Dogs are never to be left unattended in guestrooms (while they may be comfortable alone at home, in a new environment, they often get anxious). _____ initial**
- All dogs must be registered with the front desk and a non-refundable fee per dog, per night is charged upon arrival.
- Dogs are not allowed in the pool area or non-dog rooms.
- Dogs must be kept on leash at all times while in public areas. However, dogs are allowed to run free on the beach and water as long as they do not disturb other guests.
- You must 'pickup' after your dog on all areas of the property, including the sand beach. Doggie bags are provided to you and are also located around the property.
- Noise/disruption complaints – If hotel management receives more than 2 complaints, alternative arrangements must be made for your dog.
- Guest will be held responsible for any and all damage caused by, or liability arising from, his/her dog to any person or hotel property. Guestrooms will be inspected at check-out. **I authorize my credit card to be processed for any damage. _____ initial**
- No more than two dogs are allowed per room.
- Quiet times outside will be before 8am each morning and after 9pm each evening for those guests who do not care to be woken by barking dogs outside.
